This team consists of twelve local players who will travel to regional events in Atlantic Canada and compete in an Atlantic Canadian eight team League. Further cementing this move is the purchase and establishment of a six person AX3 feeder farm team; Newfoundland Knockout, which will also travel and compete in a eight team Atlantic Canadian farm league.

These new teams will allow players and teams competing on a local level to move up in the exciting sport of paintball. Frontline sponsored Newfoundland teams have a history of being competitive in mainland competitions most recently with a first and second place finish in the Atlantics held September 2007. ABOUT PAINTBALL

Paintball originated in the early 80's as a means to mark tree lines and cattle. It has evolved into one of the fastest growing sports in North America. Players at Frontline Paintball use CO₂ and air powered markers with biodegradable, gelatin covered paint balls. There are many ways to play a paintball game. Players are encouraged to create new game plans. The most common game is "Capture the Flag", which involves one team capturing another team's flag while protecting their own. X-Ball is a faster, more aggressive tournament format designed to give paintball an extreme turn. It was created by Richmond Italia and has its own sports league, the National X-Ball League (NXL). Teams of up to eighteen players field up to five players at a time, scoring a point each time they take the center flag to the opposing side of the field. The team with more points at the end of the match wins. Paintball is great exercise, fun, and exciting. Paintball is a great activity for private parties, staff parties, stag / stagettes, or just a gathering of friends.
